

## **Waste Resulting from LSL Site Activities Policy Statement**

Unless specified in a job specific contract, Lift Specialists Ltd. are considered the waste producer of any waste resulting from of our processes / activities at our clients' premises e.g. lift installation, refurbishment, repairs or servicing

As a result of this the following conditions apply:

### **Waste taken away from site by Lift Specialists Ltd.**

For non-hazardous waste there is no need to issue a transfer note as the waste has not changed ownership

For hazardous waste a consignment note must be issued to the premises owner.

Lift Specialists Ltd should be registered as a waste carrier as the waste is classified as construction waste.

Lift Specialists Ltd should also be registered as a hazardous waste producer.

The waste may be taken back to Lift Specialists Ltd premises for storage awaiting collection by another licensed waste carrier. Lift Specialists Ltd have registered an exemption under the Environmental Permitting Regulations (non-waste framework directive exemption).

A waste transfer / consignment note should be retained if the waste is taken directly to a licensed site or when the waste is collected from Lift Specialists Ltd premises.

### **Waste taken away from site by another waste carrier**

Lift Specialists Ltd should retain a waste transfer or consignment note.

The waste carrier should be registered and the waste taken to a licensed site.

### **Deposit of waste into Clients waste skips**

Waste must not be disposed of in the Clients waste skips (unless the waste has been deemed the Clients waste as specified in a job specific contract).
